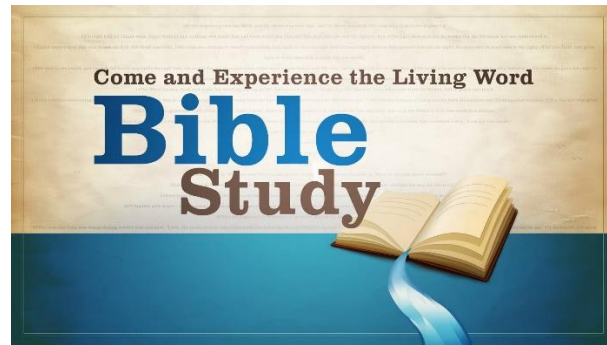


Have you ever read a Bible verse and wondered, "*What does that mean for me today*"? Sometimes, we may even wonder what it meant in Jesus' day!
